After all stats and reports are submitted to Nelson Mayer, Executive Director, ANFCA, your centre will receive payment and \$100.00 is to be provided to the youth facilitator per workshop.

For this training, on Saturday, June 4, 2011 we have 16 youth registered for the training and participation is mandatory in order to receive your workshop fees.
