1. Appointment of Elections Chair by resolution of the membership (may vote in the elections in the case of a tie) ANFCA Bylaws Article 4.6\l
2. Appointment of Election Scrutineers (non-voting).
3. Elections Chair reviews election process for the Membership.
4. Elections Chair identifies the vacant positions and length of term for each position.
5. Election Process:
 - A) Elections Chair identifies the position for which are to be called;
 - B) Motion to open nominations for the position;
 - C) Elections Chair calls for nominations from the floor (three (3) times);
 - D) Motion to cease nominations for the position until Sunday;
 - E) Re-open nominations for the positions.;
 - F) Elections chair asks candidates to accept or decline nominations. Candidates must present a Letter of Endorsement from their Friendship Centre, with a motion from a duly convened Board Meeting. ANFCA Bylaws, Article 6.2
 - G) Ballots are distributed to the membership by the Election Scrutineers;
 - H) Vote held by secret ballot;
 - I) Individual receiving the most votes fills the position;
 - J) Motion to destroy the ballots;
 - K) In the event there is one candidate for a position will be filled by acclimation.

Important Notes:

6. No proxy votes. ANFCA Bylaws, Article 4.5
7. Any delegate seeking an elected position with the ANFCA must provide a Letter of Endorsement from their Friendship Centre with a motion from a duly convened Board Meeting at the time of accepting any nomination. ANFCA Bylaws, Article 6.2
